***Treasurer's report:***

-Alexandria Pucciarelli-Miller stated that the balance dated of July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2020 was \$5,018.22. --

### ***President Gabel's Report-***

- Shockingly, we had no tournament or Hall of Fame because of the coronavirus pandemic.
- We had waited for almost two years to finalize Hall of Fame and it was time to celebrate it with the community, but we couldn't.
- We had a lot of great invitational tournaments before COVID-19 hits us.
- The entire basketball season was amazing and 95ers won the overall season championship.
- We should create a short memo to recognize historical moments during the invitational tournaments especially when there were a lot of overtimes.
- There were few new teams and it became competitive during the season. I want to recognize them too.
- USADB's Executive Committee meeting was postponed because they wanted us to focus on International Director and to split USADB/International then pass on to regions for the delegates to vote.
- I know that there was a rumor about USADB's open position, Commissioner, but I promise that I am not running for this position. My heart belongs to EAAD and I won't abandon the organization.
- EAAD's Anti-Racism Town Hall meeting was successful, there were more dialogue about Black Lives Matter, and people are more open to discuss about the issues within the EAAD community. We always focus on basketball event, but the folks had brought up new issues that we should look at. The information can be found under Vice-President's report. ### ***Vice President Clarke's Report-***

Welcome to 2020 EAAD Delegates Meeting! I want to thank the delegates and the Boards for having faith and working throughout with me as an interim Vice President. This position is my first time for a well-known and well-organized organization. My main role as a Vice President is to ensure that we all follow the bylaws and constitution. I feel that I am more involved with EAAD than I used to be.

I reviewed all minutes from 2011 to 2019 and compared our latest bylaws which is 2017. I have been busy updating entirely bylaws/constitution based on previous minutes. Guess what! I made a new Bylaws/Constitution booklet which includes many different guidelines such as regional tournament, sanctioned invitational tournament, hall of fame and tournament host guideline in current word doc version. I also developed page numbers and a table of contents where you can browse exactly information you are looking for. From now on, you will find red word(s) and that indicate update/change along with year. Year indicated which year delegate was passed to add, correction or remove. All of the delegates and board will have access to it in PDF format via both google drive and email. Hopefully it will be posted on a website for the public. Anytime we update bylaws/constitution, I will make sure that this position for current and future to maintain update in the drive and email so that you all have the latest booklet. I have a lot of proposals for bylaws/constitution related to typo and need to update based on current circumstances.

I am very sad that we had to postpone our regional tournament. But hey, our health comes first, and I am glad that everyone is ok.

On July 15<sup>th</sup>, Yarlenny and myself hosted our very first EAAD Virtual Townhall at 7:20pm and I think it was a very healthy dialogue and discussion. Results from the town hall meeting, the community came up with several suggestions, and we will take them in consideration. The referees should work closely with the EAAD board to make sure that there are no bias. The EAAD board will make sure that there is diversity on the security committee. EAAD board will allow individuals to make their motions and explain to them if it is out of order. The players should be able to express their issues about their coaches to the EAAD board. Greek members, the EAAD is a top organization, the community knows that the players makes the organization the best, and if we see an individual doing something wrong then we as community make sure to take accountability for this individual. EAAD explained briefly about what had happened at West Virginia in 2017 and how racism played a role in the games. EAAD vows to never host at WV again. Lastly, the community understood that favoritism is part of our daily lives and it is almost impossible to remove this in the EAAD community because each coach of the team wants to win.

National Deaf Basketball Organization has extended our membership to next year due to COVID-19.

I will explain more about several motions that were referred to the Law Committee.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation with us throughout this pandemic.

#### *Secretary Miller's Report-*

-Extending the deadline to Jan 15<sup>th</sup>, it creates more problem with the form, especially when players leave the teams, and then it falls to Yarlenny or myself to fix the forms.

-I am disappointed in coaches who keeps telling us a different story about the forms, deadlines, rumors that they have heard from others without asking me directly.

-I want to emphasize that anyone who tries to overstep my role as a secretary is not acceptable in my book.

-Season 2021, it is over therefore we should receive a new form for next season, but we should keep their membership intact until the season is back. We cannot speak for the insurance as the rate varies per year.

-Honestly, I think Facebook Messenger is the best way to reach all the coaches for upcoming tournament, EAAD news, but official messages should be used via emails only. We also need to set up ground rules to use EAAD messenger.

-It is much easier to use electronic payments/transactions which is easier for the audit to do their work.

-Player's registration form, we still have not found a right one (online format) because of the costs.

-I know that there has been a talk that I am part of a female sorority organization at Gallaudet University, but I want to emphasize that has nothing to do with EAAD or who I am with EAAD.

-EAAD Website- we are still working on this with the web designer who lives in Indiana and we had a brief discussion on how to improve the website especially with the memory/speed with the current bandwidth.

-Now, I would like to explain you the timeline of Jeremias Valencia, former FAAD president, who has been suspended from the FAAD, and with the understanding that FAAD has never reached out to EAAD.

1. He got a job offer at Maryland in 2018, he wrote a resignation letter to FAAD which means he will no longer serve as a FAAD president.

2. One year later in 2019, he received a letter of suspension from the FAAD after the EAAD tournament at Rochester, NY in March (an email with date was proven to the EAAD Board)

3. FAAD never sent a letter to EAAD or reached out to any of the EAAD officers, they knew that Jeremias was on one of the team in 2017/2018 therefore they could extend a courtesy to inform us.

4. FAAD send a letter to USADB in March of 2019, USADB asked them to bring evidence/reason of suspension at the Executive Committee Meeting at USADB Indianapolis 2019.

5. FAAD claimed that they did not bring the documents/evidence and forgot to bring it to the meeting then USADB veto their suspension. USADB stated that he can be suspended in their region only, but not at the national level. They vetoed because they did not bring any evidence to support their justification and no communication on their end.

6. We had a new season, 2020, EAAD sent an email to FAAD to follow up about the suspension, we had never received any correspondence from them, and we, EAAD Board, voted that their suspension is void because of lack of communication.

7. EAAD and FAAD do not share same regions, we don't have any bylaws about players being suspended from other regions. For example, if we had suspended a player from EAAD, and they CAN join another region to play. Our bylaws only refer to ban them playing at the national level once suspended from the region.

8. New Business at USADB Executive Meeting; Suspension Decision; if the issue is within the region, and has nothing to do with the USADB, a player can play at the USADB tournament. If it is related to the USADB, then the procedures must be followed. Right to appeal: The procedures and process were explained. The Deputy Commissioner will investigate the organizational chart in the Bylaws (i.e. A player joins the regional tournament, but not playing at the USADB tournament. Why is David

Hamilton suspended at the USADB level when he's not at the regional level? So therefore, he should play in the regional tournament.)

*Tournament of Director Torres' Report-*

- Let's welcome the following teams to EAAD, Phenoms, Philadelphia Wildcats, Hybrids, Lady Challengers, SICD Magic, and Ontario!
- Thank you for voting in to invite Ontario to the EAAD tournament.
- 8 Invitational tournaments this year!
- We want to continue using live drawing for witness purposes and it is easier to fix the issue at the spot instead of meeting in person.
- Let's have a special recognition for the following teams for their participation during the overall season! 95ers, Block G, DMV Diplomats, and SICD Magic.

-For single elimination bracket format, if there are more than 8 teams (9+), the time clock shall run continuously until the last 2 minutes of both halves, the time clock shall stop on everything.

-For double elimination bracket format, the time clock shall run continuously until the last 2 minutes of both halves, the time clock shall stop on everything

-For round robin bracket format, the time clock shall run continuously until the last 2 minutes of both halves, the time clock shall stop on everything.

Old Business- (NONE)

Grievance

Roxanna Aguilo filed a grievance against Danny Gabel (Vice President Clarke Investigated)

1. Allegedly that he had harassed her through Facebook Messenger throughout to Dec 2019 after Roxanna set up a private Facebook group to impeach Danny.
  - a. Investigation: Harassment is ongoing situation. Danny stopped reaching out to her by end of the Dec month. This is not harassment.
2. Roxanna said that the officers should not contact the members through Facebook messenger.
  - a. Investigation: There is no by-laws written about how the officer should communicate with the members and it never said that it must be through e-mails only.
3. EAAD's Invitational Tournament at Lexington School for the Deaf on Jan 4th, 2020 Danny approached Roxanna to follow up about the impeachment and stealing players (Interviewed 3 Witnesses)

**Concluded Investigation:** EAAD finds Danny not responsibility for his tone and approach towards Roxanna.

*Rationale:* 1. Inconsistencies of the witness's statements (witness changed his story twice),  
2. accused offenses of the situation has changed over the time (harassment, oppression, racism, sexism)

Impeachment of President Danny Gabel

-A letter by Roxanna Aguilo with 16+ signatures from last year's delegates to impeach the President. (2/3 quorum must meet to impeach the president)

-Presidents have the right to defend himself in this process.

-Signatures cannot be confidential, it must be shown, and we received several the people, not their signatures (based on the RRO)

-Secretary Miller received a name of the list and called the individuals, some of them claimed that they had never said yes to the impeachment. Note: some of the delegates were from 2019 at Rochester who are not currently at the delegates meeting.

  - i. USADB Officers reached out to EAAD about her misleading vlogs.
- e. Overstepping officers' duties without permission
